


The ICAEW's Associate Chartered Accountant (ACA) Qualification typically takes three years to complete and is valued around the world in business, practice, and the public sector. Placements

If you're wondering whether a career in accountancy is for you, doing a placement with us is a great idea. You'll earn a competitive salary, it'll look great on your CV and you'll get a real insight into what being an accountant is all about. We recruit new graduates every year, so impress us with your placement and this could be a foot in the door for your long-term career with us!

Students on our Placement Scheme are given the opportunity to gain the ICAEW's Certificate in Finance, Accounting and Business (CFAB) Qualification, which is an internationally recognised qualification that provides a taster for the Chartered Accountancy Qualification. We offer placements to students who have completed the second year of their degree for a period of twelve months, typically starting in September.
